**APPROVING THE SUPPLEMENTAL GUIDELINES TO DA-MEMORANDUM CIRCULAR NO.3,
SERIES OF 2021 ON THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ORGANIC HUB PROJECTS, OTHERWISE
KNOWN AS ORGANIK KONEK**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act 10068 (RA 10068), otherwise known as “The Organic Agriculture Act of 2010” established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, RA 10068 has been amended by RA 11511, and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, The National Organic Agriculture Board approved the “Implementing Guidelines for the Establishment of Organic Hub or Organik Konek” which was issued by the Department of Agriculture as Memorandum Circular No. 3 series of 2021. However, during the dissemination and evaluation process of proposals, points of clarifications were raised. Thus the NOAB, in a Special Board Meeting dated August 26, 2021, instructed NOAP-NPCO to draft supplemental guidelines on the matter;

WHEREAS, the NOAP-NCPO complied with the Board instruction and subsequently crafted the supplemental guidelines and presented the same to the NOAB for approval;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, approving the Supplemental Guidelines to DA-Memorandum Circular No. 03, Series Of 2021, for the Establishment of Organic Agriculture Hubs otherwise known as Organik Konek;
