**APPROVING THE UNIFIED SET OF RULES AND REGULATIONS FOR THE
REGISTRATION OF ORGANIC PRODUCERS, PRODUCE, AND INPUTS PURSUANT TO
SECTION 17 OF RA 10068, AS AMENDED**

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act No. 10068 (RA 10068), otherwise known as “The Organic Agriculture Act of 2010” established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, RA 10068 has been amended by Republic Act No 11511 (RA 11511), and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, under Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) is the policy-making body mandated to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, Section 17 of RA 10068, as amended, provides for mandatory registration under the Department of Agriculture (DA) of organic producers, produce, and inputs, as follows:

- a. DA - Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (BAFS) shall be responsible for the registration of integrated organic farms and organic inputs such as organic soil amendments and bio-control agents;
- b. DA – Bureau of Plant Industry (BPI) shall be responsible for the registration of organic seeds, planting materials and crops;
- c. DA - Bureau of Animal Industry (BAI) shall be responsible for the registration of organic agriculture farms, livestock, poultry, and its feeds; and
- d. DA - Bureau of Fisheries and Aquatic Resources (BFAR) shall be responsible for the registration of organic fisheries and aquaculture resources and organic aquaculture feeds;

WHEREAS, in order to efficiently and effectively perform their respective mandates and functions in accordance with RA 10068, as amended, the law likewise has instructed the BAFS, BPI, BAI, and BFAR of the DA to come up with a single unified set of rules and regulations for the registration of organic produce and inputs;

WHEREAS, the above-mentioned DA Regulatory Agencies have complied with the provisions of the amended law and have presented said rules and regulations for approval of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB);

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, approving the



single unified set of rules and regulations for the registration of organic producers, produce and inputs pursuant to Section 17 of RA 10068, as amended;

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution together with the abovesaid unified rules and regulations be furnished to the Office of the Secretary of Agriculture, the BAFS, the BPI, the BAI, and the BFAR for their reference and corresponding action;
