**NOMINATING THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD (NOAB)
PERMANENT AND ALTERNATE REPRESENTATIVES TO THE NATIONAL AGRICULTURE
AND FISHERIES – EXTENSION SERVICE PROVIDERS (NAF-ESP) COUNCIL FOR ORGANIC
AGRICULTURE**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10068, as amended by Republic Act No. 11511, reaffirms that it is the policy of the State to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of R.A. 10068, as amended, established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) through the promotion and commercialization of organic farming practices, cultivation and adoption of production and processing methods which have already been developed, or to be developed, continuing research and upgrading;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of R.A. 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body mandated to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, in the implementing rules and regulations of R.A. 10068, as amended, the Agricultural Training Institute (ATI) is identified as one of the agencies tasked with the accreditation of relevant Extension Service Providers (ESPs) which are training multipliers of the capacity building initiatives of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, Department of Agriculture (DA) Administrative Circular No. 5, Series of 2021, entitled “Amended Implementing Rules and Regulations on the Accreditation of Private Agriculture and Fisheries Extension Service Providers (PAF-ESPs)” created the National Agriculture and Fisheries – Extension Service Providers (NAF-ESP) Council for Organic Agriculture (Art. IV, Section 6.1) to be chaired by ATI and wherein the NOAB is one of the members;

WHEREAS, the NOAB has deemed it wise and prudent to nominate to the said Council the NOAB Chairperson or his alternate as permanent representative and any of the three (3) small farmer representatives of the NOAB as alternate representatives;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby RESOLVES, nominate the NOAB Chairperson or his alternate and any of the three (3) small farmer representatives of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as permanent and alternate representatives, respectively, to the National Agriculture and Fisheries – Extension Service Providers (NAF-ESP) Council for Organic Agriculture;

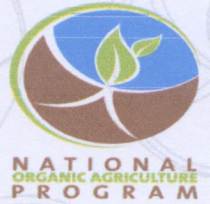
