APPROVING THE PROPOSAL FOR THE CONDUCT OF THE 2023 ORGANIC ASIA CONGRESS IN THE MUNICIPALITY OF KAUSWAGAN, PROVINCE OF LANAO DEL NORTE

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act 10068 (RA 10068), otherwise known as "The Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, RA 10068 has been amended by RA 11511 and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;


WHEREAS, the International Federation of Organic Agriculture Movements (IFOAM) - Asia, which is based in Seoul, South Korea, and established as a regional group of IFOAM Organics International in 2012, is the only regional umbrella organization of the organic movements in Asia. It has more than 270 members in 22 countries and is officially registered as a legal entity in South Korea as a non-profit organization;

WHEREAS, the Municipality of Kauswagan in the Province of Lanao del Norte, is the leading organic municipality in the Philippines. Led by the Honorable Rommel Arnado and with the support of the local Sangguniang Bayan of Kauswagan, an ordinance was enacted declaring the municipality as a purely "organic" town which prohibits the sale and use of chemical fertilizers and pesticides in its farms;

WHEREAS, the League of Organic Agriculture Municipalities, Cities, and Provinces in the Philippines (LOAMCP-Ph) likewise recognized Mayor Arnado's advocacy and leadership in organic agriculture, by electing him as its current President.
