**APPROVAL OF THE NOAB CALENDAR OF ACTIVITIES
FOR CY 2023**

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10068, also known as the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, has been amended by Republic Act No. 11511 in December 2020, and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of RA 10068, as amended, established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP), a comprehensive organic agriculture program through the promotion and commercialization of organic farming practices, cultivation and adoption of production and processing methods which have already been developed or to be developed, continuing research and upgrading thereof, the capacity building of farmers and the education of consumers thereon, the extension of assistance to local government units, peoples' organizations, non-government organizations and other stakeholders including individuals and groups who are practicing and promoting these methods as well as those who are willing to do other pertinent activities, and documentation and evaluation of the program;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body that shall provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP. Further, the NOAB shall ensure full participation of peoples' organizations, non-government organizations, and other organic agriculture stakeholders, including the general public through coordination and consultative mechanisms such as, but not limited to, public hearings, meetings and joint projects;

WHEREAS, Section 8 of RA 10068, as amended, mandates the NOAB to hold regular Board meetings at least once every quarter. Special meetings may also be called at any time to discuss and address urgent matters needing immediate Board action pursuant to its Internal Rules of Procedures; Likewise, the NOAB Technical Working Group shall also meet regularly to study, deliberate and address technical concerns of the NOAB;

WHEREAS, the NOAB Secretariat presented to the Board the proposed NOAB Calendar of Activities for CY 2023 for planning and budgetary purposes;
