APPROVING THE PROPOSED UPDATING OF THE SIX-YEAR ROLLING PLAN OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE PROGRAM

WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010", as amended by Republic Act No. 11511, established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, Section No. 09 (a) of Republic Act No. 10068, as amended by RA No. 11511, provides that it is the function of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) to formulate policies, plans, programs and projects to develop and promote organic agriculture, production, processing and trade;

WHEREAS, in Rule 5.3 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA 10068 provides that a six year rolling plan of the NOAP with the corresponding annual physical targets and budgetary requirements shall be submitted to the Board for approval. Moreover, the consolidated six (6) year program must include projects identified by the LGUs, NGOs and OSFOs/organic farming organizations must be reviewed, monitored and evaluated periodically. (Note: To be updated based on the provisions of IRR of RA 11511)

WHEREAS, in Section 7 of the LGU Organic Agriculture Code/Guide that in developing the Organic Agriculture Ordinance and Roadmap, the LGU through its LTC/OA shall promulgate appropriate provincial and/or city/municipal ordinance or resolutions that would promote participatory and bottom-up approach to grassroots organic agricultural programs and projects and that each LGU's Organic Agriculture roadmap must be anchored on the NOAP Document;

WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB), through the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) of the DA, shall assist the Municipal LTCs in crafting their organic agriculture roadmap which will be the foundation of the national roadmap/updated six-year rolling plan (FY 2022-2028) of the organic industry.

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to approve the plan to update the six-year rolling plan of the National Organic Agriculture Program.

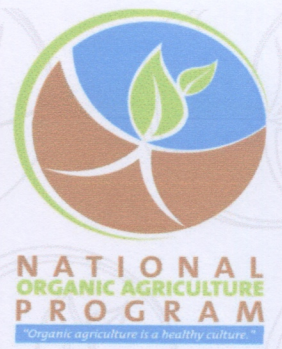
