APPROVAL OF THE IMPLEMENTING GUIDELINES FOR THE PROVISION OF SCHOLARSHIP GRANTS TO STUDENTS ENROLLED IN BS AGRICULTURE MAJORING IN ORGANIC AGRICULTURE OR OTHER UNDERGRADUATE PROGRAMS WITH CERTAIN SPECIALIZATIONS ON ORGANIC AGRICULTURE

WHEREAS, Section 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the “Organic Agriculture Act of 2010,” as amended by Republic Act. 11511, stated that there is hereby established a comprehensive organic agricultural program through the promotion and commercialization of organic farming practices, cultivation and adoption of production and processing methods which have already been developed, or to be developed, continuing research and upgrading thereof, the capacity building of farmers and the education of consumers thereon, the extension of assistance to local government units (LGUs), peoples’ organizations (POs), nongovernment organizations (NGOs) and other stakeholders including individuals and groups who are practicing and promoting these methods as well as those who are willing to do other pertinent activities, and documentation and evaluation of the program;

WHEREAS, Section 5, Rule 5.10 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations of Republic Act No. 10068, as amended by RA No. 11511, states that the NOAP shall provide assistance such as but not limited to equipment, facilities, and scholarships to educational institutions to strengthen the integration of organic agriculture in their curricula;

WHEREAS, the granting of scholarship assistance to students shall encourage capable and deserving youth to pursue studies in organic agriculture;

WHEREAS, the provision of scholarship shall serve as a route to increase the number of organic agriculture adaptors in the country as it carries out the initiative of the Program to support the youth in their interest to enter the industry of organic agriculture;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended by RA 11511 has **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVES**, to approve the Implementing Guidelines for the Provision of Scholarship Grants to Students Enrolled in BS Agriculture Majoring in Organic Agriculture or other Undergraduate Programs with Certain Specializations on Organic Agriculture;




