**INSTRUCTING THE BUREAU OF SOILS AND WATER MANAGEMENT (BSWM) TO DRAFT THE GUIDELINES FOR THE DISTRIBUTION OF COMPOSTING FACILITY FOR BIODEGRADABLE WASTE (CFBW) AND SMALL-SCALE COMPOSTING FACILITY (SSCF) INCORPORATING AND DELINEATING THEREIN THE ROLES OF THE DA-REGIONAL FIELD OFFICES (RFOs) IN THE IDENTIFICATION, VALIDATION, AND MONITORING OF CFBW AND SSCF BENEFICIARIES**

**WHEREAS**, the Republic Act 10068 or the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, as amended by Republic Act 11511 as defined in Section 4, to promote and encourage the establishment of facilities, equipment, and processing plants that would accelerate the production and commercialization of organic fertilizers and other inputs;

**WHEREAS**, the law has mandated that the NOAB, as the policy-making body of the National Organic Agriculture Program, shall constantly devise and implement ways and means not only of producing organic fertilizers and other farm inputs and needs on and off the farm but also of helping to alleviate the problems of community or industrial waste through appropriate methods of sorting, collecting and composting;

**WHEREAS**, the BSWM Organic Agriculture Program (OAP), under the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) of the Department of Agriculture (DA) implemented by the Bureau of Soils and Water Management (BSWM) plans to undertake a massive distribution of Composting Facility on Biodegradable Waste (CFBW) and Small Scale Composting Facility (SSCF);

**WHEREAS**, the CFBW and SSCF are efficacious means of converting biodegradable wastes into organic fertilizers or compost that could be used by organic agriculture farmers in the production of organic rice, corn, vegetables, high-value crops, and other crops;

**WHEREAS**, through this technological intervention, the NOAP will be able to assist rural and urban communities to improve their net income and reduce their production cost in the long run and strengthen the institutional capability of Local Government Units (LGUs) and other beneficiaries to produce organic fertilizer in the short run. However, there are still no existing guidelines for the project implementation to date;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, directing the Bureau of Soils and Water Management (BSWM) to draft the Guidelines for the distribution of Composting Facility for Biodegradable Waste (CFBW) and Small Scale Composting Facility (SSCF) incorporating and delineating therein the roles of Regional Field Offices (RFOs) in the identification, validation, and monitoring of CFBW and SSCF beneficiaries.

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




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
