**DIRECTING THE NOAP IMPLEMENTING AGENCIES (IAs) TO SUBMIT ALL COMPLETION REPORTS OF RESEARCHES CONDUCTED**

**WHEREAS**, Section 5 of the Republic Act 10068 (RA 10068), otherwise known as "The Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

**WHEREAS**, Section 4 (b) of Republic Act No. 10068 (RA 10068), states that the program shall promote research, development and extension of appropriate, sustainable environment and gender-friendly organic agriculture;

**WHEREAS**, the main purpose of research is to inform action, gather evidence for theories, and contribute to developing knowledge in a field of study and is one of the key fundamentals to develop a modernize and industrialize organic agriculture;

**WHEREAS**, in line with the discussion during the FY 2022 Planning Workshop dated December 13 - 16, 2021 of the programs, the NOAB observed that the presentation on research by the IA lack substance, ie. findings, progress reports, terminal reports, etc.;

**WHEREAS**, mature technologies developed by researches should be converted into Information and Education Campaign (IEC) materials in order to inform action;

**NOW, THEREFORE**, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, directing the NOAP Implementing Agencies (IA) to submit all completion report of researches conducted with packaged IEC materials without prejudice to the Board request for progress report as deemed necessary. Failure to submit the required reports without acceptable justification, as may be considered by the Board, will result in ineligibility for funding in future application.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that a copy of this resolution be furnished to the Office of the Secretary of Agriculture and NOAP IAs for their reference and information.
