**DIRECTING ALL NOAP-OPERATING UNITS TO SUBMIT PROPOSALS WITH
CORRESPONDING TARGETS FOR FUNDING SUPPORT FOR THEIR RESPECTIVE
STATIONS**

WHEREAS, Section 4 (c) of Republic Act No. 11511 (RA11511), otherwise known as "The Act Amending the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" states the promotion and encouragement of the establishment of facilities, equipment and processing plants that would accelerate the production and commercialization of organic fertilizers, bio-control agents, organic soil amendments and other appropriate farm inputs;

WHEREAS, the DA Stations shall serve as production, training and research facilities for the production of organic farm inputs, showcasing of organic agriculture technologies and practices, and strengthening the capability of the farmers in organic agriculture;

WHEREAS, it is necessary to conduct proper monitoring and evaluation on the status of all DA stations to ensure the effectiveness of the facilities funded by the NOAP;

WHEREAS, in line with the presentation of Regional Field Offices on the performance and fund support to DA Stations within their area during the FY 2022 Planning Workshop of the National Organic Agriculture Program dated December 13-16, 2021, the NOAB realized the need to optimize the utilization and efficiency of DA stations;

WHEREAS, the further improvement of DA stations will result to increased production of organic inputs and number of farmer-beneficiaries or organic practitioners, and lower production cost thereby contributing to the modernization of organic farming, as well as improving the status of the organic agriculture industry in the Philippines;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, directing all NOAP-Operating Units to submit proposals with corresponding targets for funding support for their respective stations.






