WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act 10068 (RA 10068), otherwise known as “The Organic Agriculture Act of 2010” established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, RA 10068 has been amended by RA 11511 in January 2021, and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, one of the projects of the Program is the establishment of organic agriculture hubs or the “Organik-Konek”, which is envisioned to be a one-stop shop for organic agriculture produce and products;

WHEREAS, for the first batch of applicants, there were eight (8) proponents who had fully and satisfactorily undergone the three (3) stages of screening and evaluation process as set in the guidelines for the establishment of the organic hubs or Organik-Konek. However, the release of funds for the said projects are subject to the compliance of the of the eight (8) proponents with the comments, recommendations and other documentary requirements as per the guidelines and subsequent issuances, including existing government accounting rules and regulations and availability of funds;

WHEREAS, once the funds are available the Board shall determine the final allocation for each proposal;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to approve the following organic agriculture hub business plan proposals:




