Guidance in the evaluation of Project Proposals for National Organic Agriculture Program funding

RESOLVED, That to provide guidance in the evaluation of project proposals the following National Organic Agriculture Program Components shall be given the following ranking and percentage allocation from the Organic Fund:

- pph*
1. Production and technology support
(including processing) 25%
 2. Extension and capability building
(private sector as beneficiaries) 20%
 3. Research and development 15%
 4. Results-based monitoring and evaluation 5%
 5. Institution development and strengthening
(including policy: government entities as beneficiaries) 15%
 6. Market
(including advocacy, communication, education, packaging, promotion, social marketing, certification, labelling) 20%

RESOLVED FURTHER, That project proposals received shall be categorized into the following:

Small scale projects shall include projects whose funding requirement does not exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos Only (P1,500,00.00.00) shall be assessed by the Technical Working Group of the Regional Field Unit and Implementing Agency and shall be approved by the Regional Field Unit.

Medium scale projects shall include projects whose funding requirement exceed One Million Five Hundred Thousand Pesos Only (P1,500,00.00.00) but does not exceed Five Million Pesos (P5,000,00.00) shall be assessed by the Technical Working Group and shall be approved by the Board at the appropriate NOAB committee.

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Large Scale projects shall include projects whose funding requirement exceed Five Million Pesos Only (P5,000,000.00) but does not exceed Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,00.00) shall be assessed by the Technical Working Group and shall be approved by the Board.

Strategic projects shall include multi-year project projects whose funding requirement exceed Ten Million Pesos (P10,000,00.00) , are national in scope shall be assessed by the Technical Working Group and shall be approved by the Board.
