APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE METHODOLOGY OF THE DEVELOPMENT ACADEMY OF THE PHILIPPINES (DAP) FOR THE CONDUCT OF A NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE PROGRAM MONITORING AND EVALUATION (TERMINAL ASSESSMENT) AMOUNTING TO SEVEN MILLION ONE HUNDRED TWENTY ONE THOUSAND THREE HUNDRED SEVENTY SIX PESOS AND FIFTY CENTAVOS (P 7,121,376.50)

WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (Program);

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA No. 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the Program;

WHEREAS, Rule 5.8 of RA No. 10068 provides for the conduct of NOAP progress monitoring and program benefit monitoring and impact evaluation of key organic programs, plans and projects;

WHEREAS, the NOAB through the National Organic Agriculture Program - National Program Coordinating Office (NOAP-NPCO) requested various consultancy firms such as the Philippine Institute for Development Studies (PIDS), Southeast Asian Regional Center for Graduate Study (SEARCA), and University of the Asia and the Pacific (UA&P) to propose for the conduct of assessment but all have expressed their regrets to conduct the assessment due to limited time and workforce;

WHEREAS, the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) was the sole consultancy firm that proposed to provide services for the conduct of the NOAP Progress Monitoring and Evaluation (Terminal Assessment);

WHEREAS, in view of fulfillment of the said provision, the National Organic Agriculture Program - National Program Coordinating Office (NOAP-NPCO) shall spearhead the conduct of the NOAP Progress Monitoring and Evaluation (Terminal Assessment) and shall commission the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) for this purpose.

NOW, THEREFORE, this Honorable Board, hereby resolves, to approve and adopt the attached Methodology of DAP for the conduct of the NOAP Progress Monitoring and Evaluation (Terminal Assessment) amounting to Seven Million One Hundred Twenty One Thousand Three Hundred Seventy Six Pesos and Fifty Centavos (P 7,121,376.50) in Annex A.



RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the NOAP-NPCO and the DAP shall adopt the resolution and utilize the National Organic Agriculture Program funds for the conduct of the Terminal Assessment.

RESOLVED FINALLY, that the Secretary of Agriculture and the NOAP Coordinating Office be furnished with copies of this resolution, for reference and appropriate action.
