**APPROVING THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE PROGRAM (NOAP) FY
2023 PLAN AND BUDGET PROPOSAL (PBP) FOR ADDITIONAL TIER II**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10068, as amended by Republic Act No. 11511, reaffirms that it is the policy of the State to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of R.A. 10068, as amended, established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) through the promotion and commercialization of organic farming practices, cultivation and adoption of production and processing methods which have already been developed, or to be developed, continuing research and upgrading;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of R.A. 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body mandated to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, the NOAB, in its Board Resolution No. 004, series of 2022, approved the Plan and Budget Proposal of the NOAP for FY 2023 in the amount of Php512 Million representing Tier 1 and an additional budget of Php387.3 Million representing Tier 2;

WHEREAS, the Program has identified additional projects and activities in line with the "OneDA" approach that will address the needs of organic agriculture practitioners and stakeholders;

WHEREAS, the NOAB-TWG, during its meeting held on 21 June 2022, discussed and recommended the approval of the proposed additional Tier 2 of the NOAP for FY 2023 in the amount of Php260,732,180.00 for the establishment of organic seed banks, Organic Konek, and upgrading of USM central laboratory for agricultural research;

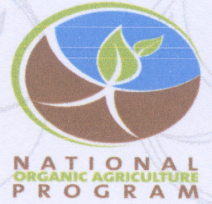




