NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD Resolution No. 03 Series of 2023

APPROVING THE REVISED GUIDELINES FOR THE SELECTION AND APPOINTMENT OF REPRESENTATIVE FROM AGRICULTURAL COLLEGES AND UNIVERSITIES AS MEMBER OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD (NOAB)

WHEREAS, Republic Act No. 10068, also known as the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, has been amended by Republic Act No. 11511 in December 2020, and Section 2 thereof states to the effect, that the State reaffirms its policy to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of RA 10068, as amended, established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body that shall provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of RA 10068, as amended, prescribes the new composition and qualifications of the members of the NOAB, including the representative from agricultural colleges and universities who shall be selected and appointed by the Secretary of Science and Technology from among nominees submitted by their national organizations; the representative must represent his/her organization at least from the provincial level, actually and actively practicing and promoting organic agriculture practices, be conversant in organic agriculture and be committed to the policies and programs provided under the Act;

WHEREAS, Rule 7.4 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (DA-DAR-DOH-DILG-DOST-DTI-TESDA-NCIP Joint Memorandum Circular No. 01, series of 2021) of RA 10068, as amended, likewise directs the Department of Science and Technology to formulate the criteria and guidelines for the selection of the academe representative, subject to the approval of the NOAB;

WHEREAS, the DOST presented the guidelines for the selection and appointment of the representative from agricultural colleges and universities, for approval of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB);

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by the powers vested in it by RA 10068, as amended, has RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, approving the Guidelines for the Selection and Appointment of the Representative from Agricultural Colleges and Universities as member of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB);

RESOLVED FINALLY, that a copy of this Resolution together with the above-said revised guidelines be furnished to the Office of the Secretary of Science and Technology for the corresponding administrative issuance;
