WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA 10068, as amended, to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, one of the projects of the Program is the establishment of organic agriculture hubs or the "Organik-Konek", which is envisioned to be a one-stop shop for organic agriculture produce and products;

WHEREAS, for the first batch of applicants, there were eight (8) proponents who had fully and satisfactorily undergone the three (3) stages of screening and evaluation process as set in the guidelines for the establishment of the organic hubs or Organik-Konek.
