## National Organic Agriculture Board Resolution No. 004 Series of 2012

## APPROVING AND ADOPTING THE DRAFT GUIDELINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ORGANIC TRADING POST

**WHEREAS,** the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010 (RA 10068) was enacted to foster the growth of organic farming and to promote the consumption of organic products in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, RA 10068 recognizes the need to foster the growth of the market for organic produce and inputs to further strengthen organic farming in the country;

**WHEREAS,** Section 18 and 19 of RA 10068 provides for the establishment of trading posts for organic inputs and produce where purely organic products will be traded;

**WHEREAS**, to facilitate establishment of trading posts for organic inputs and produce and to ensure the strategic set-up of each post, the draft guidelines was drafted through the DA – Agribusiness and Marketing Assistance Service;

**WHEREAS,** the draft guidelines has been carefully scrutinized by the Board and deemed to be appropriate to meet the mandate of the law;

NOW, THEREFORE, the Board hereby RESOLVES to approve and adopt the DRAFT GUIDELINES FOR THE ESTABLISHMENT OF ORGANIC TRADING POST (ANNEX A).
