NOAB Resolution No. <u>663</u> Series of 2013

WHEREAS, Section 5 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" ("Act") established the National Organic Agricultural Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, Section 6 of the Act created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) which shall be the policy-making body that shall provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, Section 4 of the Act provides for the promotion and encouragement of the establishment of facilities, equipment and processing plants that would accelerate the production and commercialization of organic fertilizers, pesticides, herbicides and other commercialization of organic fertilizers, pesticides and other appropriate farm inputs;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Plant Industries is tasked with the main organic agriculture mandate of developing technologies vital to seed production for plant variety perpetuation and organic feed production necessary for organic livestock production;

WHEREAS, in relation to this mandate, the following projects were proposed by BPI as one of the implementing agencies for Organic Agriculture:
