NOW, THEREFORE, this Honorable Board, in view of the fulfillment of the  $10^{\mathrm{th}}$  NOAC resolution, the Board had identified corresponding lead stakeholders/agencies that shall be responsible for the specific items in the said resolution (Annex A).

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the Secretary of Agriculture and heads of the identified stakeholders/agencies be furnished with copies of this resolution, for reference and appropriate action.



# ANNEX A. NOAB Agreement on the 10<sup>th</sup> National Organic Agriculture Congress Resolution

The following are the identified stakeholders/agencies responsible for the specific items in the  $10^{\rm th}$  NOAC resolutions:

1. That the Department of Agriculture (DA) shall conduct annual consultations or consultative conferences for Indigenous Peoples (IPs) on Organic Agriculture to develop OA Agenda, programs and projects for IP Communities.	DA OSC
2. That Regional or Island-wide Organic Agriculture Conferences shall be conducted giving emphasis to small-scale farmers including awards.	RFUs

5. The AMAS shall be called upon to develop mechanisms of collaboration with socially oriented market, such as the Fair Trade Movement, both local and foreign.	AMAS
6. That the DA shall encourage and facilitate the creation of local or regional organic certifying bodies to lower certification costs and to achieve the targets of the program.	AMAS and RFUs
7. That the DA shall conduct studies to explore the merits of other certification and guarantee systems such as Participatory Guaranty System (PGS) which are represented as more accessible and appropriate to small farmers and develop recommendations for submission to COCAFAM;

13. That the establishment of post-harvest and tertiary processing facilities for organic products of small farmers shall be actively supported;	PHilMech, RFUs and LGUs through the RFUs, DILG
