WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (Program);

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA No. 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the Program;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board takes cognizance of the exemplary performance of the local government units and organic agriculture farmers and fisher folks toward the attainment of the goals and objectives of the Program

WHEREAS, the National Organic Agriculture Achievers' Awards is conducted annually to recognize and incentivize the top performing local government units, focal persons, agricultural extension workers, small farmers, farmers groups, farming families with outstanding contribution in the promotion and development of organic agriculture in the country;

WHEREAS, the guidelines is revised to effectively implement the search for outstanding achievers in organic agriculture;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to recommend for the approval of the revised guidelines for the conduct of the National Organic Agriculture Achievers' Awards;


RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the draft revised guidelines shall be endorsed for review of the Legal Service of the Department.
