RECOMMENDING THE APPROVAL OF THE GENERAL GUIDELINES FOR THE SEARCH OF THE BEST ORGANIC AGRICULTURE RESEARCH PAPER AND POSTER

WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (Program);

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA No. 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the Program;

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board takes significance on the role of research in the promotion, development, and adoption of organic agriculture;

WHEREAS, the Bureau of Agricultural Research (BAR) is mandated to identify, prioritize, and implement research projects and related activities on organic agriculture through collaborating agencies;

WHEREAS, the BAR acknowledges the efforts of scientists and researchers in conducting researches and generating technologies that contributes towards the improvement of the agriculture and fisheries sector particularly the organic agriculture industry;

WHEREAS, the BAR includes the organic agriculture research category in the National Research Symposium to recognize the best researches on organic agriculture;

WHEREAS, a general guidelines has been developed to serve as basis for the search of the best organic agriculture research paper and poster;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, has RESOLVED, as it hereby RESOLVES, to recommend for the approval of the general guidelines for the search of the best organic agriculture research paper and poster.

RESOLVED, FURTHER, that the NOAB shall be included as member of the evaluation panel for the best organic agriculture research paper and poster.

RESOLVED, FINALLY, that the BAR shall commence with the search based on the general guidelines.
