**APPROVING THE PROJECT PROCUREMENT MANAGEMENT PLAN (PPMP) AND  
WORK AND FINANCIAL PLAN (WFP) NECESSARY FOR THE IMPLEMENTATION OF  
THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD (NOAB) ACTIVITIES**

**WHEREAS**, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (Program);

**WHEREAS**, the Honorable Board is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA No. 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the Program;

**WHEREAS**, pursuant to Section No. 08 of the Act, the NOAB is authorized to determine the budget to be allocated for its operations or activities including the travel expenses, allowances, per diems etc. of its non-government members;

**WHEREAS**, Section 9 of the Act enumerates the powers and functions of the NOAB, to wit:

- a. formulate policies, plans, programs and projects to develop and promotes organic agriculture, production, processing and trade;
- b. oversee the successful implementation of the NOAP;
- c. Identify sources of financing to expand organic agriculture;
- d. monitor and evaluate the performance of programs for appropriate incentives;
- e. undertake measures for the international recognition of local certification of organic products;
- f. call upon any government agency to carry out and implement programs and projects identified by the NOAB
- g. Call upon private sectors and CSOs to provide advice;
- h. submit annual and other periodic reports;

**WHEREAS**, in line with the mandates of the NOAB, the following priority activities shall be implemented this year:

- 1. NOAB Consultation Workshop/Conference (National SUC Consultation on Organic Agriculture);
- 2. Capability Building Workshop for the NOAB; and
- 3. NOAB regular/special meetings and its technical committee meetings.

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**WHEREAS**, considering that the above-cited activities are among the regular operations and due to the fact that the NOAB FY 2017 budget is limited, the NOAB deems it appropriate for its activities to be procured and charged against the FY 2016 Continuing Appropriations;


**NOW, THEREFORE**, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, has **RESOLVED**, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to approve the Project Procurement Management Plan (PPMP) and Work and Financial Plan (WFP) necessary for the implementation of the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) activities amounting to Two Million Nine Hundred Thirty Thousand Eight Hundred Pesos (PhP2,930,800.00);

**RESOLVED FURTHER**, that the PPMP and WFP be further subjected to the approval of the Bids and Awards Committee (BAC) and Procurement Division of the Department of Agriculture Central Office.

**RESOLVED FINALLY**, that the Secretary of the Department of Agriculture, members of the NOAB, Chair of the BAC, the Chief of the Procurement Division, and the Executive Director of the Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards be furnished with copies of this resolution for proper guidance and appropriate action.
