**ADOPTING THE RECOMMENDATIONS OF THE END OF PROGRAM ASSESSMENT
FOR THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE PROGRAM**

WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (Program);

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board as the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the NOAP;

WHEREAS, Section 5 of the RA No. 10068 states that a progress monitoring and program benefit monitoring and impact evaluation of the key programs, plans and projects of the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP) shall be conducted within three (3) years of its implementation;

WHEREAS, the NOAB approved the assessment methodology submitted by the Development Academy of the Philippines (DAP) through Resolution No. 18, Series of 2016;

WHEREAS, the primary objective of the End of Program Assessment is to assess the overall accomplishment of the Program in terms of results achieved after the 2012-2016 implementation, identify and extract lessons, and propose recommendations to enhance impacts and results of the program.

WHEREAS, the DAP presented the results of the End of Program Assessment and the recommended strategies to improve and enhance the Program's institutional arrangements, mechanism, and process with corresponding timeframe as enumerated in the attached Annex A;

NOW, THEREFORE, considering the foregoing, this Honorable Board, by virtue of the powers vested in it by RA 10068, has resolved, as it hereby **RESOLVES**, to adopt the recommendations of the end of program assessment for the National Organic Agriculture Program.

RESOLVED FURTHER, that the results of the End of Program Assessment shall serve as one of the references for the formulation of appropriate policies or interventions for the improvement or enhancement of the implementation of the Program.
