NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD Resolution No. 22 Series of 2020

RECOMMENDING THE RESULT OF THE SELECTION OF NON-GOVERNMENT REPRESENTATIVES OF THE NATIONAL ORGANIC AGRICULTURE BOARD FOR THE TERM OF OFFICE 2020-2023

WHEREAS, Section No. 05 of Republic Act No. 10068 otherwise known as the "Organic Agriculture Act of 2010" established the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, the Honorable Board is the policy-making body mandated under Section 6 of RA No. 10068 to provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the Program;

WHEREAS, Section 7 of RA No. 10068 prescribed the composition of NOAB with members from government line departments and representatives from small farmer organizations each from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao, non-government organizations (NGO), agricultural colleges and universities, and private sector or agribusiness firms;

WHEREAS, the same Section authorized the Secretary of the DA to choose from thesubmitted nominees of the small farmer organizations each from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao, non-government organizations (NGO), and private sector or agribusiness firms;

WHEREAS, Rule 7.1 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of RA No. 10068, mandates the DA through the Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (BAFS) to come up with criteria for the selection of the above-cited representatives;

WHEREAS, in accordance with Rule 7.1, a set of guidelines was issued to specify the rules and procedures for the selection of non-government members of the NOAB including the creation of the National Technical Search Committee (NTSC) for this purpose;

WHEREAS, after completing the series of activities following the guidelines, the NTSC came up with the result of the selection of the non-government members representing small farmer organizations from Luzon, Visayas, and Mindanao; and non-government organization (NGO) for the term of office 2020-2023;

WHEREAS, the NTSC guaranteed that utmost diligence and faithful application of selection rules/criteria in all stages of validation were observed throughout the selection process to ensure that only the most qualified among the nominees would be endured for final selection.
