**REQUESTING THE ASSISTANCE OF THE
LEAGUE OF CITIES AND MUNICIPALITIES OF THE PHILIPPINES (LCP/LMP)
ON THE REQUIREMENTS FOR THE ISSUANCE OF MAYOR'S PERMITS
TO PGS CORE GROUPS/OCB UNDER R.A. 11511**

WHEREAS, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10068 or the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, as amended by Republic Act No. 11511, declares the policy of the State to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

WHEREAS, Section 6 of R.A. 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body that shall provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

WHEREAS, Section 14(a) of R.A. 10068, as amended, has identified the Participatory Guarantee System (PGS) as the mechanism by which small farmers/fisherfolk, their farms/associations/cooperatives shall be certified as engaged in organic agriculture and as producers of organic agriculture products;

WHEREAS, Section 3(t) and 3(u) of R.A. 10068, as amended, define **PGS group** and **Core PGS group**, as:

*“(t) **PGS group** refers to a legal association or cooperative of registered farmer members and other stakeholders in a participatory guarantee system; and
(u) **Core PGS group** refers to the basic grouping unit in the PGS.”*

WHEREAS, Section 14(b) of R.A. 10068, as amended, requires that **the core PGS group** applying for certification shall be registered with the municipality/city where the PGS group is predominantly located, that it **shall secure a mayor's permit** from said municipality/city, **possession of which shall suffice as proof of registration and the grant of legal personality**, which shall however be limited only to PGS transactions; Further, an **organic certifying body (OCB) shall also secure a mayor's permit** from the municipality/city where it intends to operate and **possession of which shall suffice to grant them legal personality for purposes of accreditation** by the Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (BAFS);

WHEREAS, some PGS Core Groups applying for certification/accreditation encounter challenges in securing mayor's permit from their municipalities/cities because they were required to present a registration either from the Securities and Exchange Commission (SEC) or the Department of Trade and Industry (DTI) or the Cooperative Development Authority (CDA);

WHEREAS, Articles III.6 and VII of the DA-DILG Joint Memorandum Circular No. 1, series of 2022, encourages all local government units (LGUs) to support the operations of PGS groups in their locality through the provision of technical and financial assistance; Further,



the LGUs are encouraged to facilitate the issuance of the mayor's permit to PGS groups and PGS farms, the possession of which shall grant them legal personality;

NOW, THEREFORE, this Board, by virtue of the power vested in it by R.A. 10068, as amended, has **RESOLVED**, as it is hereby **RESOLVED**, to request the assistance of the League of Cities of the Philippines (LCP) and the League of Municipalities of the Philippines (LMP) to enjoin the city/municipal mayors to support the PGS groups in their locality and facilitate the issuance of the mayor's permit to PGS core groups/PGS organic certifying body even without registration with the SEC, DTI or the CDA as provided for under R.A. 11511;

RESOLVED FURTHER, that a copy of this resolution be forwarded to the Offices of the Leagues of Cities/Municipalities of the Philippines for appropriate action;
