APPROVING THE "GUIDELINES FOR THE ACCREDITATION OF CERTIFYING BODIES PERFORMING THIRD-PARTY ORGANIC CERTIFICATION, REPEALING DA DEPARTMENT CIRCULAR NO. 1, SERIES OF 2018 (REVISED GUIDELINES FOR THE OFFICIAL ACCREDITATION OF ORGANIC CERTIFYING BODIES)"

**WHEREAS**, Section 2 of Republic Act No. 10068, or the Organic Agriculture Act of 2010, as amended by Republic Act No. 11511, declares the policy of the State to promote, propagate, develop further, and implement the practice of organic agriculture in the Philippines;

**WHEREAS**, Section 6 of R.A. 10068, as amended, created the National Organic Agriculture Board (NOAB) as the policy-making body that shall provide direction and general guidelines for the implementation of the National Organic Agriculture Program (NOAP);

**WHEREAS,** Section 13 of R.A. 10068, as amended, designates and authorizes the Department of Agriculture - Bureau of Agriculture and Fisheries Standards (DA-BAFS) to grant accreditation to organic certifying bodies (OCB) or entities;

**WHEREAS,** DA Department Circular No. 01, series of 2018, currently serves as the technical regulation for the official accreditation of third-party OCB, marking the fifth revision of the accreditation guidelines since the DA began recognizing OCB;

**WHEREAS**, Rule 13.2 of the Implementing Rules and Regulations (IRR) of the amended Organic Agriculture Act mandates the DA-BAFS to review and revise, as appropriate, existing guidelines, rules, and procedures for the accreditation of OCB;

WHEREAS, it has been deemed necessary to (1) harmonize the regulations with the provisions of R.A. 11511 and its IRR; (2) align the regulations with the ASEAN Certification Scheme for Organic Agriculture in preparation for the Philippines' participation in the ASEAN Mutual Recognition Arrangement on Organic Agricultural Products (MRA-OAP); and (3) refine and streamline the requirements and procedures, while sufficiently harmonizing them with international standards relative to conformity assessment;

WHEREAS, the NOAB Technical Working Group (TWG), during its October 22, 2024 meeting, discussed the proposed revised guidelines for the accreditation of OCB performing third-party organic certification, and agreed to endorse the same to the NOAB for approval, on the conditions that DA-BAFS (1) implements a stakeholder consultation mechanism that allows for the participation of NOAB members and ensures that both the consultative meetings and the draft guidelines are accessible to the public, (2) subjects the guidelines for legal review, and (3) collaborates with the NOAP-National Program Coordinating Office (NPCO), in addition to the identified DA offices and the DTI-Philippine Accreditation Bureau;
